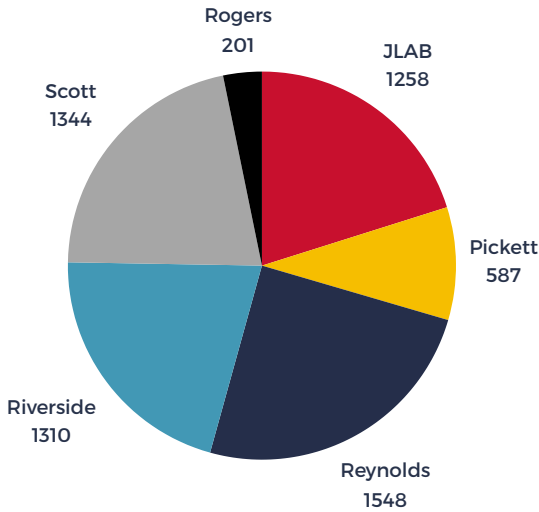


Schools as Community Hubs

HUB EVENTS

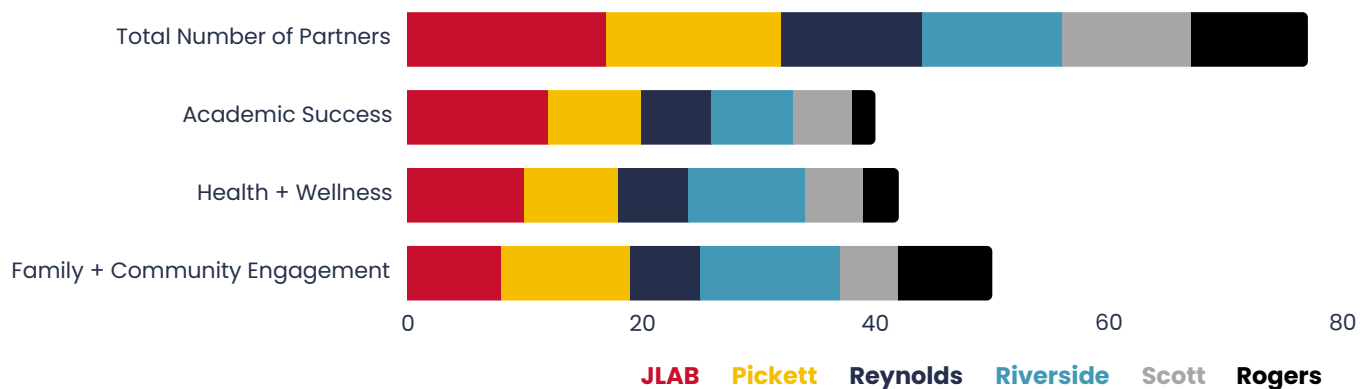
Between July 1 - December 31, 2023, the Hubs hosted a total of **53** events.

- Approximately **6,248** individuals participated in Hub events
- 20 events supported **academic success**
- 26 events promoted **health + wellness**
- 46 events facilitated **family + community engagement**

MID-YEAR HIGHLIGHTS

- Improved communications, as evidenced by 72% open rate for Hub Happenings monthly newsletter
- Established a Schools as Community Hubs Strategy Council made up of 14 community leaders
- Strengthened family connectedness and community engagement through holiday events at each Hub, sponsored and facilitated by community partners and Hub leaders
- Hosted two Hub Town Halls to identify priorities that will drive programming and partnerships.
