
Walking Club

When Your Child Is Absent...

Call the school attendance line at 419-671-7351 to report your child will not be in attendance. Please speak slowly and clearly. Please include your name, your child's name, your child's teacher or room number, the date, and the reason for the absence. If the school does not receive a note upon your child's return to school, the absence will be unexcused. Please send any medical documentation along with the note. More than <u>10</u> absences require a doctor's note.





Please communicate with your child/children all after school pick up information, who to go home with, etc. before they leave for school in the morning.

The office gets very busy during the day, and the secretary does not have a lot of time to forward messages to students. There are the cases when a real emergency arises, and that is totally acceptable.

Please try and make doctor appointments outside of school hours if possible. Students are arriving later and later to school and are missing instructional time in class. DAILY HEALTH ASSESSMENT

- Families are being asked to perform a daily health assessment, which includes whether the student has any of the following:
- Fever (100 degrees or higher), chills, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new olfactory disorder, and new taste disorder.
- If the student is sick, the parents please keep the student home. If the students begin to exhibit any signs or symptoms of COVID19 they will be sent home immediately.
