DAILY HEALTH ASSESSMENT

- Families are being asked to perform a daily health assessment, which includes whether the student has any of the following:
- Fever (100 degrees or higher), chills, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, new olfactory disorder, and new taste disorder.
- If the student is sick, the parents please keep the student home. <u>If the students</u> begin to exhibit any signs or symptoms of COVID19 they will be sent home immediately.

Please include your name, your child's name, your child's teacher or room number, the date, and the reason for the absence. If the school does not receive a note upon your child's return to school, the absence will be unexcused. Please send any medical documentation along with the note. More than 10 absences require a doctor's note.

Messages for Students

Important

Please communicate with your child/children all after school pick up information, who to go home with, etc. before they leave for school in the morning.
